Plaintiff John D. Vorce brings this Complaint for Divorce against Mary D. Vorce named as Defendant above, and shows this Court as follows:

1.

The Plaintiff is a resident of Fulton County, Georgia, and has been a resident of the State of Georgia for six months prior to the date of filing this Complaint. Jurisdiction and venue are proper in this court.

2

The Defendant is a resident of Fulton County, Georgia is subject to the jurisdiction of this Court, and if service is not acknowledged, service may be perfected, according to law.

3.

The Plaintiff and Defendant were lawfully married on or about January 1, 2008.

4.

The parties have since separated and are currently living in a **bona fide** state of separation.

5.

Plaintiff is entitled to a divorce from Defendant upon the grounds that the marriage is irretrievably broken and there is no possibility of reconciliation. Plaintiff reserves the right to amend this Complaint to allege additional grounds for divorce.

Vorce Complaint for Divorce Page 1 The parties have two (2) minor children born as issue of this marriage: Lucy Vorce, born 2010, and Michael Vorce, born 2012. Said minor Children are in the present care, custody, and control of Plaintiff and Defendant.

7.

Pursuant to the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act, O.C.G.A. §19-9-69, Plaintiff shows the following:

- a) The minor Children presently live with Plaintiff and Defendant at 123 Any Street, Atlanta, Georgia 30000.
- b) During the past five years, the minor Children have lived with Plaintiff and Defendant at the following address: 123 Any Street, Atlanta, Georgia 30000.
- c) Plaintiff has not participated as a party or witness or in any other capacity in any other proceeding concerning the custody or visitation with the minor Children.
- d) Plaintiff does not know of any proceeding pending in this Court or any other Court of this State or any Court of another State that could affect the current proceeding, including proceedings for enforcement and proceedings related to family violence, protective orders, termination of parental rights, and adoptions.
- e) Plaintiff knows of no other person not a party to this proceeding who has had legal or physical custody of the minor Children or claims to have custody or visitation rights with respect to said minor Children.

8.

Plaintiff is entitled to joint legal and primary physical custody of the Children on a temporary and permanent basis.

9.

Plaintiff is entitled to an equitable division of the parties' marital property, both real and personal, and Plaintiff requests that both parties be restrained and enjoined from disposing of marital assets during the pendency of this action except as in the ordinary course of business. Plaintiff is entitled to be awarded his separate property.

10.

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Unless otherwise agreed by the parties, Plaintiff is in need of and entitled to an award of reasonable attorneys fees and temporary and permanent alimony from the marital estate.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays for the following relief:

- a) That Plaintiff be awarded joint legal and primary physical custody of the minor Children on both a temporary and permanent basis;
- b) That Plaintiff be awarded an equitable division of the real and personal property of the parties;
- c) That Plaintiff be awarded his separate property;
- d) That Plaintiff be awarded alimony and attorneys fees;
- e) That Plaintiff be awarded a total divorce upon legal principles;
- f) That the parties be restrained and enjoined from disposing of marital assets except in the ordinary course of business;
- g) That Summons and process issue requiring the Defendant to be and appear and answer this Complaint as provided by law;
- h) That the Court adopt any Settlement Agreement entered into between the parties into a Final Order of the Court;
- i) For such other and further relief as the Court deems proper.

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
